NARCAN VENDING MACHINE AND MAIL OUT PROGRAM



On August 31, 2022, in recognition of International Overdose Awareness Day, DuPage County Health Department unveiled a Narcan Vending Machine. The Machine dispenses a free Narcan kit which includes two doses of naloxone nasal spray.

The Narcan Vending Machine is conveniently located inside the lobby of the Linda A. Kurzawa Community Center (115 N. County Farm Rd, Wheaton) where mental health services and substance use treatment is offered. Not only does this reduce barriers in accessing Narcan, but it also reduces the stigma associated with getting it.

The Narcan Vending machine is the first of its kind in DuPage County and a vital resource for people in the community to reduce the amount of opioid related deaths and save lives. The vending machine has dispensed more than 450 Narcan kits since its launch.

The DuPage Narcan Program also offers free Narcan to community members through a mailout program. In 2022, 368 Narcan kits were mailed out. Information about requesting a kit can be found at hopedupage.org.






