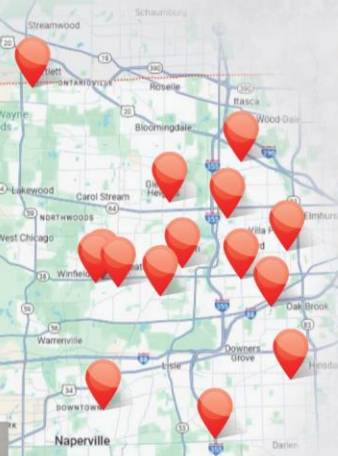

doses have been mailed to the community in 2023.

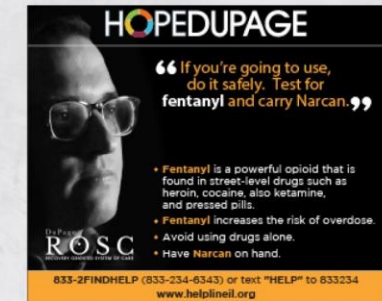
4 New partnerships

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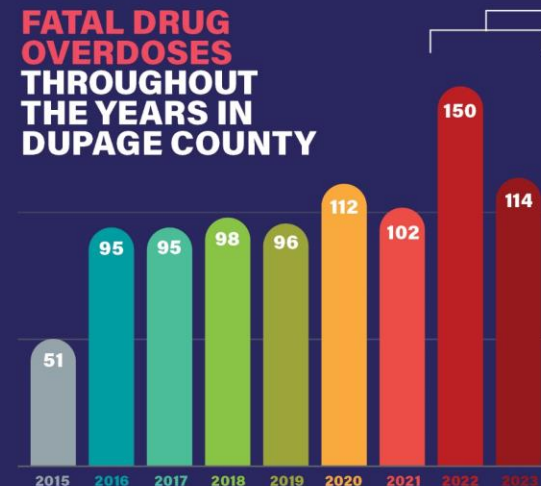

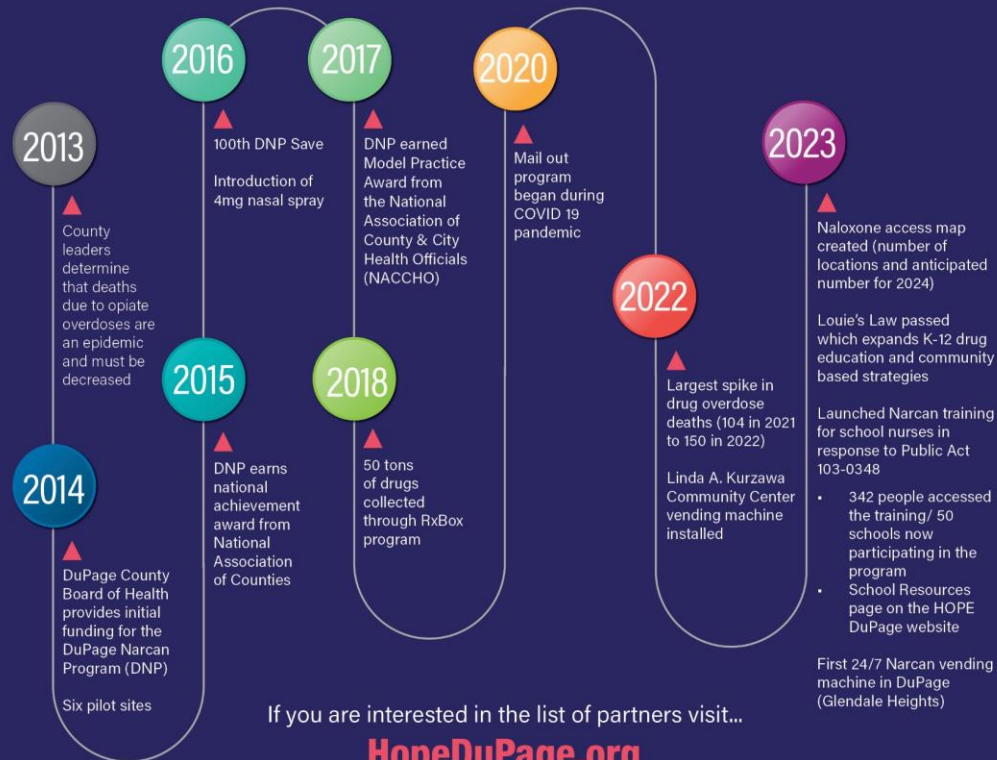
