► Crisis Services (630) 627-1700

Services are available 24 hours a day,
7 days a week, and 365 days a year

Crisis Services are staffed by highly-trained counselors who respond to DuPage County residents who may be experiencing a psychiatric crisis or are in need of additional support for symptoms of mental illness. Crisis Services staff provides brief intervention, support, guidance and linkage to Behavioral Health Services.

Services Include:

- Crisis walk-in counseling and assessment of needs
- Mobile crisis response for adults and youth at location of crisis in order to determine appropriate level of care
- The SASS (Screening Assessment and Support Services) Program provides intensive mental health services for children and adolescents who may need hospitalization for behavioral health care. Referrals come through Statewide CARES Hotline, 1-800-345-9049
- Linkage to services for residents coming out of a psychiatric hospital or jail
- Crisis Residential Unit – 12 bed unit for adults who are experiencing an increase in psychiatric symptoms but do not require inpatient hospitalization.
- National Suicide Prevention Lifeline provider: 1-800-273-TALK
- Psychiatric evaluations
- Short term crisis counseling
- Trauma and Disaster Team

► Child and Adolescent Services

The Child and Adolescent Program provides outpatient behavioral health services to children and adolescents with emotional problems.

Services Include:

- Consultation to schools and youth serving organizations
- Services for individuals experiencing behavior health illness and substance use
- Psychiatric evaluation and medication management
- Individual, group, and family counseling
- Linkage to community resources
- Wraparound planning and service coordination
- Crisis intervention
- Parent education and support
- Assistance with Family Support Program (FSP)

► Adult Services

Adult Services provides treatment and support to adults ages 18 and older experiencing behavioral health and emotional problems. To promote recovery, our comprehensive program assists DuPage County residents to cope and manage while living independently in their community.

Services Include:

- Individual, group and family counseling
- Medication management
- Case Management Services
- (CST) – Community Support Team provides intensive community-based rehabilitation and support to individuals with complex needs and/or multi-system involvement
- Educational classes
- Psychosocial Rehabilitation – Outpatient Plus Recovery Services (OPPR) provides classes and groups that support the functioning of the individual to promote a higher quality of life

► Residential Services

Residential Services assist adults with psychiatric illness in living as independently as possible. A wide array of services are offered in the residential setting which lead to increased functioning and supporting the resident in living as independently as possible.

Services Include:

- Group Homes
- Apartment Programs
- PAS Pre-Admission Screening

► Forensic Behavioral Health

The Forensic Behavioral Health program provides mental health & substance use treatment for those also involved in the criminal justice system. Programs include Substance Use treatment, Mental Illness Court Alternative Program (MICAP), Special Needs Advocacy Program (SNAP), Re-Entry assistance from jail, and Partner Abuse Intervention Program (PAIP).
